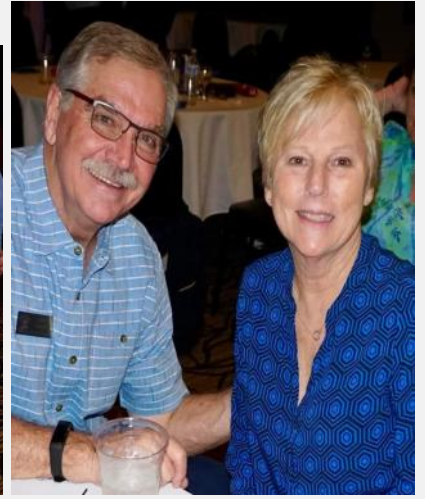

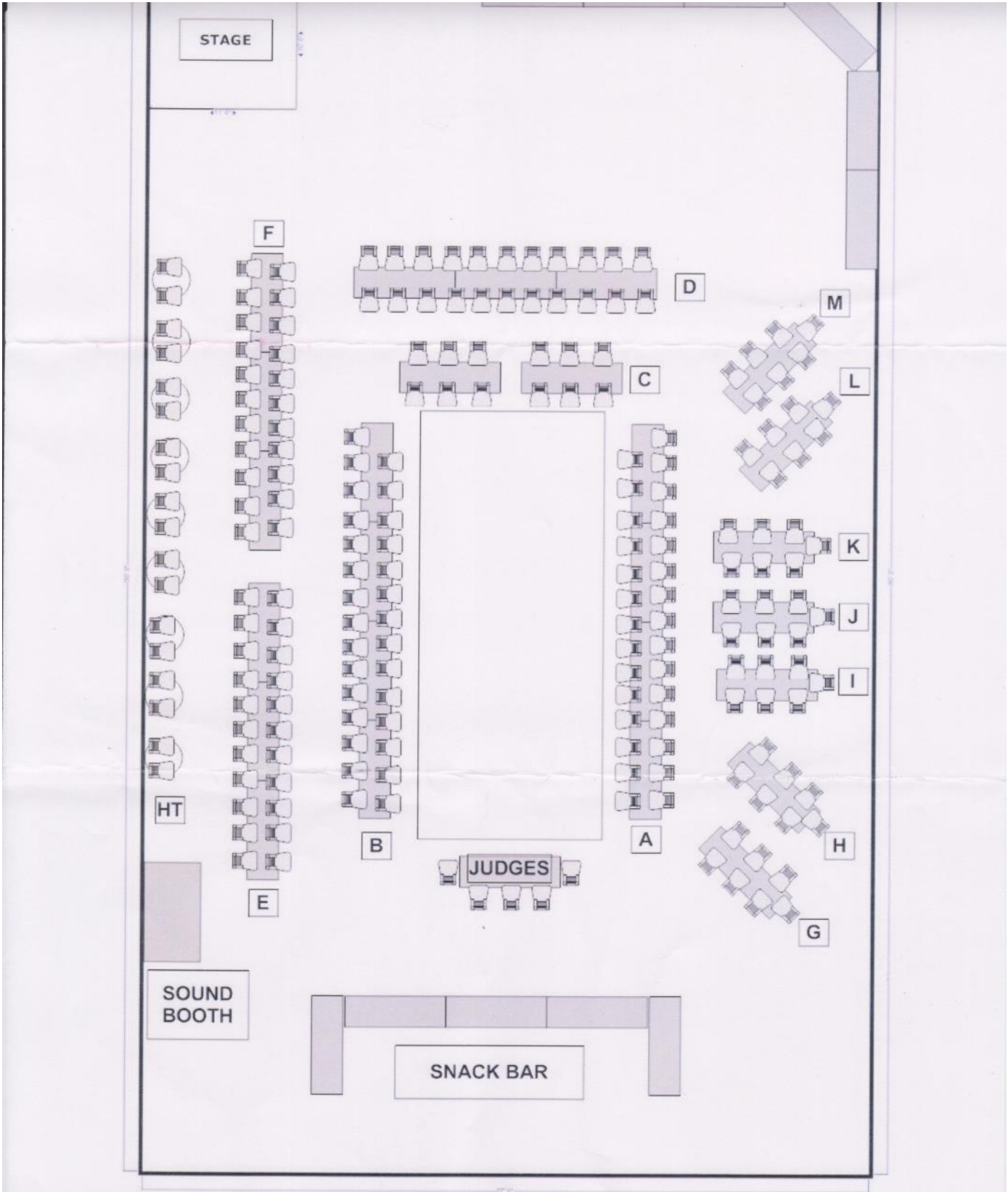

## Why join a shag club?

The one word answer is **opportunity**.

Without your club periodic social dances would not exist. Without other clubs in the area there would not be other shag dancing opportunities in the area. Without all the other shag clubs the ACSC (Association of Carolina Shag Clubs) would not exist. Without the ACSC, the SOS (Society of Stranders) would not exist.

What was just described is a hierarchy based on local shag clubs throughout the country, all with the same objective—promote and enjoy the form of dancing we know as shag dancing. The foundation of this structure is the local shag club. A local shag club may apply for membership in the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs. Once in the ACSC a club adheres to



ACSC general rules and policies to present a common image for the shag community.

The Society of Stranders (SOS) is a management structure at the top of this pyramid. SOS promotes two major events a year—Spring Safari in April and Fall Migration in September. During these two ten-day events some ten-to-twelve thousand shaggers converge on North Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, to enjoy one of the premier dancing venues in the country. SOS encompasses multiple clubs in North Myrtle Beach (and surrounding areas) and an SOS card provides you unlimited access to most everything going on—club entry, Dee Jays, live bands, vocal artists, etc.

SOS also promotes a four-day weekend in January referred to as Mid-Winters. Then in the summer there is “Junior SOS”—focusing on the future of shag dancing.

Bottom line—joining a club provides opportunity. Your benefit is not just a periodic newsletter or a reduced rate for event attendance or a periodic freebie at the club. Sure, the club would be there without your being a member, and you’re welcome to visit whenever you like. You’re also welcome to join and help make sure the “opportunities” continue to exist.

# Celebrating 40th Anniversaries

## The ASSOCIATION OF CAROLINA SHAG CLUBS (ACSC)



was founded in 1984. The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs, Inc. (hereafter known as A.C.S.C. or as the Association) is an organization of autonomous shag clubs. Its purpose is to provide for communications among the clubs, to serve as a coordinating body for club activities, to sponsor activities of mutual interest to all clubs, and to manage and operate the Society of Stranders, Inc. (hereafter known as S.O.S.). The goal of the A.C.S.C. is to promote and preserve the heritage of beach music and shag dancing, to inform its members of beach music and shagging activities of wide interest, and to help diminish schedule conflicts among its members' activities. The Association will also assist groups that wish to establish shag clubs Workshops, which once attracted forty to fifty participants, now regularly attract well over 200. Serious business related to Association expansion, development, and benevolence, can occupy the most committed people in the Shag World for hours: All the while, serious parties are underway, often just next door.



## THE SOUTH CAROLINA STATE DANCE

The Shag was designated as the official State Dance by Act Number 329 of 1984. The Shag is performed to music known as rhythm and blues. Both the music and dance are structured on time signature and can be performed to almost any tempo, as long as the basic step is maintained and kept in time to the music. On April 10, 1984 "The Shag" became South Carolina's official dance when Gov. Richard Riley signed the "Shag Bill"
